
The SCJGF supports programs throughout the state that help grow the game of golf at the local, regional, and statewide levels.



SOUTH CAROLINA JUNIOR GOLF ASSOCIATION

The South Carolina Junior Golf Association (SCJGA) promotes the game of golf by reaching out to the youth of South Carolina. Founded in 1990, the SCJGA provides affordable playing opportunities, instruction, and competition for boys and girls of all backgrounds and skill levels. It teaches honor, sportsmanship, and respect, helping young people gain valuable life skills.

YOUTH ON COURSE

The core purpose of Youth on Course is to provide youth with access to life-changing opportunities through golf. Members play thousands of courses for \$5 or less, benefit from employment through the caddie and internship programs, and receive college scholarships. In the United States Youth on Course serves all 50 states.

CLUBS FORE KIDS

With generous community donations, a yearly donation to honor Marilyn and Papa Ed Thompson, and the SCJGF, our association is able to provide golf clubs to kids in an effort to grow the game to all prospective junior golfers. FIRST TEE

The first tee's purpose is to enable juniors to build the strength of character that empowers them through a lifetime of new challenges. By seamlessly integrating the game of golf with life skills curriculum, the first tee creates learning experiences that build inner strength, self-confidence, and resilience that kids carry to everything they do.

SCJGF PAR FUND

The Player Assistance Reserve Fund (PAR Fund) helps financially limited junior golfers by providing financial support for local, regional, and national events. It alleviates the financial burden on players and their families, allowing them to apply for assistance. Donations to this fund can help young golfers achieve their dream of competing in Junior Golf Championships.

SCJGF EVENTS

CAN-AM TEAM MATCHES



The top 16 junior golfers from the province of Ontario take on the top 16 juniors from South Carolina in Ryder Cup style matches. Over the past 20 years, more than 125 South Carolina juniors from the Can-Am Junior Team Matches have gone on to play college golf. The matches have featured impressive performances, including players making five birdies on the front nine and seven-hole birdie streaks. Some have even achieved NCAA National Championships, a FedEx Cup title, and spots on the President's Cup team.

WATSON CUP



The Watson Cup matches, inspired by the Walker Cup, celebrate the historic golf connection between South Carolina and Scotland. This event gives juniors from both regions a chance to compete in international team events and experience different styles of play on both sides of the Atlantic.



The GA/SC Junior Team Matches, founded in 1976 by Charlie Rountree, Jr. and Floyd Doss, celebrate the unique bond between South Carolina and Georgia through junior golf. Designed to showcase top talent, the matches provide a platform for young golfers to compete in a spirited environment, fostering friendships and sportsmanship.

The Youth on Course 100 Hole Hike is an exciting annual fundraising event that challenges participants to embrace their passion for golf by playing and walking an incredible 100 holes in just one day! This thrilling endeavor showcases golfers' dedication and enthusiasm while raising vital funds to support youth programs.









Despite its catchy name, the Golf Ball isn't a "ball" at all (tuxes and long gowns are pushed to the back of the closet in favor of golf shirts and sundresses) but rather a party featuring silent and live auctions, raffle tables, gourmet hors d'oeuvres and an open bar. This party is always held during the biggest golf week of the year-Masters Week!



MEMORIAL AND PLANNED GIVING

The SCJGF Memorial Program honors people who loved golf and their lasting impact on the sport. When someone is memorialized, their name is added to a plaque displayed in the SCGA offices. This plaque lets everyone who visits the Champions Corridor see and remember those who cherished the game.

SCJGF GENERAL FUND

Provides resources for the future of the SC Junior Golf Association and the SC Junior Golf Foundation operating needs and other supported activities. Gifts to this fund are designated to assist in junior golf development programs, junior golf competitions, equipment for juniors, SCJGA general operations, and statewide junior golf programs like Hook-A-Kid on Golf, and The First Tee Facilities located around SC.



SCHOLARSHIPS

Since 1996, the SCJGF has awarded over \$1,000,000 in scholarships, helping 156 South Carolina students attend in-state colleges and universities. The SCJGF partners with the Center for Scholarship Administration in Taylors, SC, to manage this program.


